I yelled, "shut up." I tried to walk away. Or maybe I asked for the conversation to be tabled for another time. Maybe, if it were a friend, a colleague, a coach, or a clergyman, I just tried to change the subject or awkwardly giggled to make them stop talking to me.

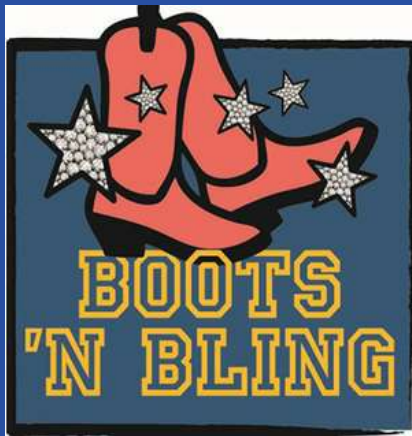
I did not invite the harm. I just thought we were talking, and then I wanted it to stop.

Starting Point is Offering an Online Volunteer Training Beginning April 10, 2023.

Since 1981 Starting Point has been providing free and confidential services to victims of domestic and sexual violence, stalking, and human trafficking. Volunteers were the founding members of Starting Point and continue to be essential members of the Starting Point team.

Volunteer positions include direct service work, office support, event support, fundraising, board work, prevention, and outreach.

All sessions run from 5 to 8 pm. to equal 30 hours, with 24 hours online and 6 hours of self-guided study. The final training date on May 8 will be held at Camp Calumet in Freedom as part of our volunteer appreciation celebration! This training includes dinner and networking with current volunteers, staff, and board members.

Dates include April 10 Intro, April 11 DV & SV 101, April 13 Court Advocacy, April 17 CAC, DCYF, April 19 Shelter, April 20 Hospital Advocacy, May 1 Confidentiality, intersectionality, and more, May 8 Volunteer Appreciation and networking at Camp Calumet in Freedom.

Once the training is complete, participants can create their own schedules, from weekly to monthly or even once a year at an event.

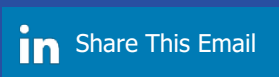
All are invited to attend the April 10 introduction to learn more about Starting Point in general. Participants of the April 10 training do not have to commit to volunteering.
